

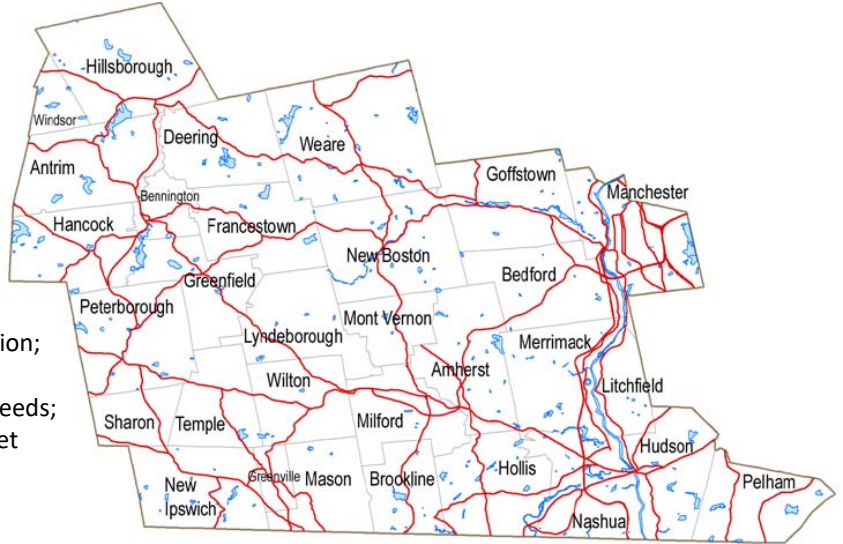

Hillsborough County occupies the south central portion of the state along a 36-mile border with Massachusetts. Hillsborough was one of the original five counties, created by the Provincial Act in 1769, authorized by Governor John Wentworth. It was named in honor of Wills Hill, Earl of Hillsborough, and a councilor of King George III. The town of Hillsborough was the birthplace of Franklin Pierce, the only United States president from New Hampshire. The town, first granted in 1735 and incorporated in 1772, was probably not named for the Earl, but for landowner Colonel John Hill.

Hillsborough County contains 877.1 square miles of land area and 15.3 square miles of inland water area. As of the 2020 Census, the population density was 452.5 persons per square mile, the highest among the counties. Hillsborough County includes two cities, Manchester and Nashua, and 29 towns. The county seat is Nashua; services are also available in Manchester.
